Sub - Information under RTI Act.

This has reference to your application dated 15/01/2015 (Recd. on 19/01/15) seeking following information under RTI Act. Our reply in this regard is as under:-

S.No.	Information sought	Our reply
1.	If manufacturing premises is situated at a disputed property, whether registration can be granted by NSIC at disputed premises?	Regarding the information sought at S.No.1 to S.No.8, our reply is as under:- We wish to inform you that as per Section 2(f) read with 2(j) of the RTI Act, the requisite information should be specific in nature. You have sought various hypothetical information in the form of queries which does not fall within the definition of 'information' as per Section 2(f) & 2(j)) of the RTI Act. As per above Section of RTI Act, only such information which is specific in nature and available in material form with the concerned Public Authority, may be provided. Since no specific information / document(s) have been sought by you, hence, such type of information is exempted from disclosure as per Section 2(f) & 2(j) of the RTI Act.
2.	If applicant is showing manufacturing premises on rent basis and on the same premises another tenant is having Court Order granting stay in his favour for entire premises, whether registration can be granted by NSIC knowing that stay order in favour of another tenant?	
3.	If electric connection is neither in the name of owner of the manufacturing premises nor in the name of applicant tenant, whether registration can be granted by NSIC merely on the basis of one affidavit only?	

4.	<p>Whether requirement of submission of purchase bills of plant and machineries by the applicant is mandatory or not. If somebody, other than applicant, is claiming ownership of those plant & machineries and challenging the affidavit submitted by the applicant, what are the steps to be taken by the NSIC as per rules?</p>	
5.	<p>If total area of tenanted manufacturing premises as shown in the rent agreement is much less than shown in the license issued by the concerned Municipal Corporation. whether NSIC will consider the area as shown in the rent agreement and will ignore the areas shown in the license of Municipal Corporation?</p>	
6.	<p>For the item Foot wears and Rubber Products (which can be manufactured only with the help of power operated machines and boiler and vulcaniser) whether fire license and NOC from concerned Pollution Control Bard is required or not?</p>	
7.	<p>After getting registration from NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme, if registration certificate holding firm sold out all the plant and machineries without intimating NSIC and apply for renewal and these facts are brought to the notice of NSIC by somebody in writing with evidence, whether renewal application can be accepted by NSIC?</p>	

8.	If any of the information furnished by the applicant firm is found/proved to be false and/or fabricated at later stage, what is the rule of NSIC in that case?
