### The terms and conditions for the work order.

#### 1.0 Definitions:-

- 1.1 "Corporation" shall mean the National Small Industries Corporation Ltd. (A Govt. of India Enterprise) Okhla Industrial Estate, New Delhi . 110020, and shall include their legal representatives, successors and permitted assignees.
- 1.2 "Competent Authority" means Chairman cum Managing Director of Corporation and his successors.
- 1.3 "Officer In Charge " shall mean the officer of the Corporation, not below the level of Deputy Manager, designated by "Competent Authority." as the case may be, who shall supervise and be in-charge of such works.
- 1.4 "Contract" means and includes the documents forming the tender and acceptance thereof together with the documents referred to therein including the conditions.
- 1.5 "Contractor" shall mean the individual or firm and shall include the legal representative of such individual or the persons composing such firm or the permitted assignee of such individual or firm or the Corporation

#### 2.0 INSTRUCTIONS TO CONTRACTOR:-

- 2.1 The Gate Scanners shall be installed at the reception gates of NSIC H.O. and STP.
- 2.2 For CCTV coverage the cameras shall be installed in the premises and outdoor and indoor cameras will be placed as per the requirement. The system should have an arrangement of displaying the view of all the cameras on the monitors simultaneously and / or separately.

- 2.7 The contractor has to provide Comprehensive AMC (CAMC) and warrantee for one year free of cost. (The agreement of AMC is enclosed at Schedule 'C').
- 2.8 The contractor shall arrange, at his own expense, all tools, plant and equipment hereinafter referred to as (T & P) and Labour.
- 2.9 The contractor should have completed at least two works of the similar nature in a Central Govt. PSU / Govt. Department / any other reputed organization /MNC of minimum value of Rs.7/- lacs (Rupees Seven lacs) each during the immediately preceding 5 years. The contractors are required to enclose the photocopies of award letters/ completion certificate. In case of the works in Pvt. Organizations/ MNC, copies of TDS certificate should also be enclosed.
- 2.10 The tenders shall be accompanied with a DD / Pay Order for Rs. 50,000.00 (Rupees fifty thousand only) drawn in the favour of NSIC Ltd., New Delhi being the Earnest Money Deposit for the above mentioned job. EMD will be refunded after the supply and installation of the above items to the best of the satisfaction of the deputed officer or committee of officers.
- 2.11 No EMD will be payable by the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) but they will have to submit a copy of the Registration Certificate along with the Technical Bid.
- 2.12 The tenders shall be valid for a period of 120 days from the date of its opening.

- 2.13 The interested contractors are advised to inspect the premises and assess the scope/quantum of work involved before submitting their offer. Clarifications, if any, may be obtained by contacting the office of the undersigned during office hours on working days. No claim what so ever shall be entertained regarding the ignorance about the site conditions on later date.
- 2.14 Price Bids shall be opened only when the Technical Bid is found to be technically qualified & other relevant documents.
- 2.15 Interested contractors are requested to quote their **most competitive rates** (as per the format specified in **Schedule 'B'**.
- 2.16 Technical & Price Bids shall have to be submitted in the Format as per **Schedule 'A'** and **Schedule 'B'** respectively.
- 2.17 Conditional tenders will be rejected out rightly.
- 2.18 Any overwriting / cutting in Technical/ Price Bids shall result in rejection of the Tender document.
- 2.19 The contractor shall not sub-contract the services of personnel engaged by them.
- 2.20 The contractor shall be responsible to compensate the loss of any kind to NSIC caused due to theft, damage or negligence by his personnel.
- 2.21 Successful contractor will have to execute an agreement on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of appropriate value before the commencement of work.

#### 3.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CONTRACTORS:-

The contractor shall submit the self-attested photocopies of the following documents:-

- a. Ownership registration certificate of the contractor.
- b. PAN Number in the name of registered owner
- c. Registration with Service Tax Department.
- d. Registration with Sales Tax Department
- e. Certificate of Authorized Dealer of the items quoted in the Price Bid.
- f. Certification of CE/FCC/UL for cameras and DVR.
- g. Experience Certificate of two works of similar nature in Govt/ Pvt/ MNC of not less than Rs. 7/- lacs in the immediately preceding 5 years.
- h. Terms and conditions as given in the tender document duly signed by the contractor on every page.
- i. EMD for Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. fifty thousand only) through DD/PO only.

#### 4.0 TIME AND EXTENSION FOR DELAY:-

- 4.1 Time allowed for execution of the work as specified in the Appendix or the extended time in accordance with these conditions shall be the essence of the contract. The execution of the contract shall commence from the 7<sup>th</sup> day after the date on which the corporation issues the Work Order to commence the work.
- 4.2 If the work is delayed by:
  - a. Force Majeure, or
  - b. Serious loss or damage by Fire, or
  - c. Civil Commotion, local combination of workmen strike or lockout, affecting any of the trades employed on the work, or

#### 5.0 FORCE MAJEURE:-

Any delays in or failure of the performance of either party shall not constitute default herein shall not constitute default hereunder or give rise to any claim for damages. If any, to the extent such delay or failure of performance is caused by occurrences such as Act of God or the public enemy, expropriation or confiscation of facilities by Government Authorities or in compliance with any order or request of

any Governmental authorities, or acts of war, rebellion or sabotage or fires, floods, explosions, riots, or illegal joint strikes of all the workers of all the Contractors / Suppliers.

#### 6.0 MATERIAL:-

All materials to be provided by the Contractor shall be in conformity with the specifications laid down in the contract and the Contractor shall, if requested by the officer-in-charge, furnish proof of satisfaction in this regard.

#### 7.0 LABOUR:

- a. The contractor shall employ its labour in sufficient numbers to complete the work in the stipulated time. The contractor shall not employ any person who has not completed eighteen years of age.
- b. All labour shall be deployed by the contractor and corporation shall not have any liability what so ever with regard to such labour.
- c. The contractor shall comply with all statutory norms of Central/ State Govt. with regard to labour employed by him. Violation of any such norm shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
- d. The contractor shall indemnify and keep the corporation indemnified against all such claims arising out of :-
  - Third party loss/damage to life or property caused by / during execution of the work.
  - ii. Loss / damage to the workmen engaged by the contractor during the execution of the work.
  - iii. Due to the non-compliance of applicable PF/ Labour Laws, ESI Regulations etc.

#### 8.0 INSPECTION:

The officer in-charge or his representative shall have the powers to inspect and examine any part of the work at any time and the contractor shall give such facilities as may be required for such inspection and examination.

#### 9.0 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR DELAY:-

In case the contractor fails to complete the whole work within the stipulated time, he shall be liable to pay liquidated damages @ 1% (one percent only) of the value of the contract per week and /or part thereof of the delay subject to a maximum of 10% (ten percent) of the value of the contract. The amount of compensation may be adjusted or set-off against any sum payable to the Contractor under this or any other contract with the corporation.

#### 10.0 DEFECT LIABILITY PERIOD:-

The Contractor shall be responsible to make good and remedy any defect in the work executed within defect liability period of one year which shall be reckoned from the date of completion of the works to the corporation.

#### 11.0 PAYMENT TERMS:-

11.1 After carrying out the entire work successfully, the contractor shall submit the bill to the corporation for payment.

- 11.2 10% of the accepted tender cost shall be retained as Security deposit which will be refunded to the contractor after defect liability period of 12 months. Earnest money deposit (EMD) (if payable) shall be adjusted in the security deposit.
- 11.3 No interest shall be payable to the contractor on the security deposit.
- 11.4 All statutory deductions as applicable like TDS, Sales Tax/ VAT etc shall be deducted from the Contractor's Bills.

#### 12.0 ARBITRATION:-

- 12.1 Except where otherwise provided for in the contract, all questions and disputes relating to the meaning of the words, terms, specifications, operations, and instructions, mentioned in this contract and as to the quality of workmanship or performance of the contractor any other question, claim, right, matter, or thing whatsoever in any way arising out of or relating to the contract, specifications, operating instructions, orders or these conditions; or otherwise concerning the performance of the contract, the execution or failure to execute the same whether arising during the progress of the work or after the completion or abandonment thereof, shall be referred to the sole arbitration of Director (Planning & Marketing) of the corporation or any other officer appointed as the sole arbitrator by Director (Planning & Marketing).
- 12.2 The Arbitrator shall have power to call for such evidence by way of affidavits or otherwise as he thinks proper and it shall be the duty of the parties hereto to do or cause to be done, all such things as may be necessary to enable the Arbitrator to make the award without any delay. The Arbitrator shall give a separate award in respect of each dispute or difference referred to him. The venue of arbitration shall be such place as may be fixed by the Arbitrator in his sole discretion. The Award of the Arbitrator shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties to the contract.
- 12.3 The law under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall be applicable to such proceedings.

#### Whereas M/s

has quoted its rates for supply, installation, testing and commissioning of Gate Scanners and CCTV in NSIC Head Office & STP premises at Okhla Industrial Estate, New Delhi-110020 and thereafter to provide comprehensive AMC and warrantee for a period of one year from the day of commissioning of the project.

NOW IT IS agreed by and between the parties as under:-

- 1) The contract for providing free Comprehensive AMC and warrantee shall be deemed to have come into force on day of the month of of the year 2012.
- 2) The contract shall be valid for the period from .2012 to .2013.
- 3) The contractor shall service and maintain the equipments in good working order during the continuation of the agreement.
- 4) The contractor shall depute his service engineer to visit the premises at least once in every month (30 days) for preventive check up and also on request of the officer in-charge in case if any defect is reported.
- 5) The contractor shall be responsible for removing the defect within 24 hrs of lodging of the complain.
- 6) The Contractor shall engage the personnel who has attained the age of 18 years...
- 7) The contractor shall not transfer, assign, pledge or sub-contract its rights and liabilities under this contract to any other contractor without prior written consent of the corporation.
- 8) In case the defect is not removed within 24 hrs of lodging the complain, the contractor will be liable for a penalty of Rs. 500/- per day subject to a maximum of Rs.5000/- out of the security deposit, after which the agreement will be terminated and the Security Deposit shall be forfeited.
