**General Conditions of Contract**

For Depot Operation (storage, handling and allied works) of Bitumen Emulsion and allied products of HINCOL at Jamshedpur.

**A. Scope of Work:**

NSIC is desirous of appointing a Sub-Contractor for storage and handling of Bitumen Emulsion and allied products of HINCOL at Jamshedpur (Jharkhand). The Sub-Contractor shall be responsible for unloading the products from trucks, storing, invoicing, loading into trucks, security and all related operations including business solicitation/sales promotion efforts.

The terms & conditions of the contract will be as mentioned hereunder:-

1. The Sub-Contractor shall provide storage space measuring around 3000 sq.ft. with boundary wall and partial/full cover to store minimum 50 MT of product in drums. The land should either be owned by the Sub-Contractor or should be taken on lease ideally for 3 years with a renewal option for another term.
2. The Sub-Contractor shall have to enter into an agreement with NSIC as per standard format of NSIC. The agreement shall initially be for a period of 1 year and may be renewed subject to the performance of the Sub-Contractor.
3. The Sub-Contractor is required to arrange for storage and handling facility of HINCOL products on the date of signing the agreement.
4. The Sub-Contractor shall be responsible for making watch & ward arrangement for the godown and shall take all steps for proper custody of the goods from the time of unloading till the disposal of goods at their cost.
5. The Sub-Contractor will also provide necessary facilities for unloading, raming & disposal of HINCOL products requiring mechanical handling in the godown and/ or manual labour as may be required.
6. On arrival of the consignment at the godown, the Sub-Contractor shall undertake all the works connected with unloading of HINCOL products & loading the same (preferably with a ramp arrangement) at the time of delivery as may be assigned to them by NSIC/HINCOL.
7. HINCOL will dispatch material from their plants and/or from other Godowns to Sub-Contractor's godown at Jamshedpur. On arrival of materials, Sub-Contractor will receive the material from the authorized transporter of HINCOL.

On receiving the material, Sub-Contractor will ensure that the description and quantity is in conformity with the description given on the Challan. Any discrepancy needs to be informed to NSIC/HINCOL immediately and would be sorted out by joint inspection by NSIC/HINCOL and the Sub-Contractor. However, in the event of any shortage, Sub-Contractor will obtain shortage certificate/endorsement on challan from transporters and immediately inform NSIC, Jamshedpur/HINCOL for lodging claims with the Transporters/Insurance Co.

8. That Sub-Contractor will deliver the material only against delivery instructions issued by authorized signatory of NSIC/HINCOL and send the documents immediately/next working day. Sub-Contractor will also obtain customer's signature thereon to the effect that they have received the material as per the challan-cum-invoice. Wherever required, Sub-Contractor will also obtain L/Rs from concerned transporters on delivery of material, as per NSIC/HINCOL instructions & courier the same immediately/ next working day. Xerox copies of test certificates have to be provided by the Sub-Contractor along with invoices to customers.
9. That Sub-Contractor shall maintain proper record of accounts in respect of receipts of stocks and dispatches. Sub-Contractor will maintain required register and other records/receipts required by Tax authorities/any other statutory authority. Sub Contractor will give all documents to the NSIC/ HINCOL office by 2<sup>nd</sup> of the month pertaining to the previous month as the statutory returns are to be filed by NSIC/ HINCOL by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month pertaining to the previous month. The above should be available for internal audit verification, physical examination or for any other purpose.
10. NSIC/HINCOL shall send dispatch intimation to Sub-Contractor by e-mail. The Sub-Contractor shall intimate to NSIC/HINCOL all consignment remaining in transit for more than a month from the date of dispatch to enable NSIC/HINCOL to lodge claims with transporters/Insurance Company for missing trucks/shortage.
11. The material stored in godown will be property of HINCOL. Sub-Contractor shall have no right, title or change of ownership over the property. Sub-Contractor will be trustee on behalf of NSIC/HINCOL and in the event of any breach occurs; Sub-Contractor will be liable for penal civil action for breach of trust.
12. In respect of the staff/officials appointed by the Sub-Contractor, the Sub-Contractor shall comply with all provisions of the Shops and Establishments Acts (if applicable) and all other Central and Local Acts which may be applicable in respect of the Sub-Contractor's staff/officials. All permits and other Licenses will continue to remain in the name of the Sub-Contractor and License fee in this regard will be paid by the Sub-Contractor.

13. Sub-Contractor will send a stock report daily along with the copies of L/R etc. in respect of sales upto that period along with a statement showing item-wise breakup of stocks received, delivered and balance material in godown. Sub-Contractor's official should be present strictly on all working days of NSIC/HINCOL.
14. That Sub-Contractor shall take all steps for proper custody of the goods from the time of unloading in premises till its disposal and any loss or shortage during such custody shall be borne by Sub-Contractor. Any type of charges/Local charges(if any) applicable at the time of unloading, loading etc. will have to be borne by the Sub-Contractor & should be inclusive of rates quoted by the Sub-Contractor. No extra charges will be paid by the transporters belonging to either NSIC/ HINCOL or its customers. However, any tax or such other similar statutory/local charges as may be raised under any local laws; the same shall be borne by NSIC/ HINCOL against proper receipt.
15. That the Sub-Contractor shall not have any right to pledge or hypothecate the material and shall hold the material on behalf of NSIC/ HINCOL. Sub-Contractor will exhibit near entrance to the godown in a prominent place indicating the ownership of HINCOL in respect of the goods stored therein.
16. Sub-Contractor shall carry out work during Monday to Saturday and also on Sunday & public holidays, depending on exigency arising in the interest of the progress of the work, without any extra charges to NSIC/HINCOL. Notice in advance will be given by NSIC/HINCOL to open the godown on holidays. Sub-Contractor's official deputed at NSIC/HINCOL godown would strictly follow only public holidays being observed by NSIC/HINCOL in addition to Sundays. The designated godown-in-charge of the handling Sub-Contractor should be contactable to NSIC/HINCOL round-the-clock. Sub-Contractor should provide contact details (telephone numbers of godown as well as residence/mobile number) of its staff/official deputed at NSIC/HINCOL godown.
17. The Sub Contractor will keep the Depot and its surroundings in a clean and satisfactory condition. All maintenance and repairs of the depot premises, required by NSIC/HINCOL or the Sub Contractor, will be carried out by the Sub-Contractor at their own cost. The Sub-Contractor shall notify NSIC/HINCOL immediately of the necessity of any repair or adjustment.
18. That Sub-Contractor shall give all facilities to the representative of NSIC/HINCOL for checking of stock, stocking arrangements or to conduct surprise stock verification etc. at any time without prior intimation.
19. That Sub-Contractor shall provide additional labour for stock verification if necessary without any extra cost.

20. Sub-Contractor shall take adequate measures/pre-cautions to safeguard the materials at godown against theft, pilferage, damages of any kind. Any loss /shortages occurred during storage shall be recoverable from Sub-Contractor without prejudice to any other actions.
21. This agreement would be subject to "Force Majeure" circumstances including Act of God, any event of stoppage of work in any establishment of NSIC/HINCOL/Sub-Contractor due to riots, strike, fire, lightning, tempest, cyclone, typhoon, hurricane, flood, Lockout, trade disputes, breakdown accident, Government Action/Orders and shortage of material or causes beyond the control of NSIC/HINCOL/Sub-Contractor.
22. HINCOL shall take insurance at their own cost on the full value of the products stored at the Depot.
23. Stock insurance of the godown shall be arranged by HINCOL at their cost. Insurance cover will be in favour of HINCOL.
24. Stock Delivery:  
Stock delivery services to be provided under this agreement shall be as follows:-
- a. Sub-Contractor shall arrange to deliver the stocks strictly as per NSIC/HINCOL delivery instructions. The Sub-Contractor shall arrange material handling facilities for unloading and loading of materials on trucks under proper supervision. The Sub-Contractor shall ensure that all trucks reporting at the godown during normal working hours are unloaded and released within reasonable time of its reporting. Sub-Contractor shall be fully responsible for deployment of adequate numbers of manpower and supervision so that dispatches from Sub-Contractor's premises can be effected to maintain NSIC/HINCOL schedule/buyers requirements.
- b. Sub-Contractor shall be fully responsible to ensure that stocks are delivered by them to the party authorized by NSIC/HINCOL and obtain their proper receipts. Sub-Contractor shall also hand over such documents that may be specified by NSIC/HINCOL.
- c. Sub-Contractor shall load and place the stocks on the trucks in such a manner as to fully utilize truck capacity volume wise/weight wise or as per NSIC/HINCOL instructions.
- d. All deliveries to be effected by the Sub-Contractor to HINCOL's customers shall be in the name of HINCOL and on behalf of HINCOL and while invoicing to the customers, the Sub-Contractors shall use the name and stationery of HINCOL.
25. NSIC/HINCOL reserves the right to appoint any other Sub-Contractor on the same or similar terms and conditions or otherwise to render the same or similar services during currency of the contract. The Sub-Contractor shall not restrict the right of NSIC/HINCOL to take recourse to the above parallel arrangement even if notice of termination is not served and contract terminated.

26. During the execution of the contract if any accident arises resulting in death or injury to any person including employees of Sub-Contractor, then Sub-Contractor shall be liable to bear all expenses/compensation and indemnify NSIC/HINCOL from any demands, claim or proceedings occasioned or instituted by such injured person or on his/her behalf.
27. NSIC or Sub-Contractor shall have right to terminate the contract by serving one month notice in writing without assigning any reason whatsoever. The notice period shall be effective from the date of receipt of the notice by either party. However, in the event of any breach of the terms of contract, NSIC/Sub-Contractor will have the right to terminate the contract without notice.
28. If Sub-Contractor fails to execute the work and responsibilities and fulfill the terms and conditions of the NIT, NSIC/HINCOL shall have the right to utilize the services of any other party for execution of the contract and recover from Sub-Contractor charges/expenses/ losses/damages suffered by NSIC/HINCOL. The alternative arrangement at the risk and cost of Sub-Contractor shall be made by NSIC/HINCOL without any notice. This will be without prejudice to the rights of NSIC/HINCOL for any action including termination of contract.
29. Volume of Work: The tentative program of NSIC/HINCOL is to handle material around 250 MT per month and 3000 MT for a period of one year under this contract. This quantity is purely tentative and it cannot be made an obligation to NSIC/HINCOL and subject matter of any claim or litigation by Sub-Contractor.
30. NSIC/HINCOL shall also have the right to terminate the Sub-Contractor in case of any of the following activities:
  - a. Fraud on NSIC/HINCOL/Customer
  - b. Failing to carry out any stipulation contain in the agreement for 7 days after being required in writing to do so by the company
  - c. Abandoning the works specified in the agreement
  - d. Without any lawful reasons suspend the work for 15 consecutive days
  - e. Neglect or failure in observing and performing all or any of the terms, acts, matters or things under the agreement
  - f. Act in any manner detrimental to the interest, reputation, dignity, name or prestige of NSIC/HINCOL
  - g. Detection of shortage in stocks
31. After expiry of term/ period of the contract or after termination of the contract, Sub-Contractor shall return all the materials stored or received in their godown. Sub-Contractor shall have no right to retain NSIC/HINCOL materials after termination of contract on any ground except to the extent of payment is due to the Sub-Contractor.
32. There should be no discrimination by the Sub-Contractor in the delivery of the products of the Company to the customers within the State of Jharkhand.
33. There should be no delay or laxity on the part of the Sub-Contractor in giving prompt and efficient service to the customers.

34. The deliveries will be governed by payment term policy of HINCOL.
35. The rights to be granted under the agreement are not transferable by the Sub-Contractor
36. That the agreement entered into with the successful bidder will be governed by the rules and regulations as may be specified by the Govt. of India or State Govt. from time to time in so far as they are applicable to the sale and storage of the products covered thereby. The agreement shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of Courts in Jamshedpur. In case of High Court, it is the High Court of Jharkhand which shall have the jurisdiction.

**B. Rates and Quotations:**

1. The rates quoted in the price bid shall be inclusive of all charges excluding GST.
2. The Sub-Contractor should submit proof of valid registration under GST. The Sub-contractor shall be responsible for compliance of all local municipal/State/Central Govt. Laws governing the business herein mentioned in the NIT.

**C. List of Documents to be submitted:**

**D. Contract Period:**

The duration of contract will be for a period of one year from the date of agreement/date of commencement of operation with a provision for renewal of contract on the same rates, terms and conditions as per the original contract.

**E. Validity of Offer:**

The rates quoted by tenderer shall be valid for a period of 120 days from due date of opening of Price Bid and the rates once submitted shall not be changed/ varied during this period. No claim shall lie on NSIC/HINCOL for the validity of the offer or for any costs that may arise to the tenderer on account of his participation in the tender.

**F. Payment Terms:**

For the purpose of monthly payment to the Sub-Contractor, Compensation (Rs. Per MT) would be considered on the basis of actual quantities sold. This compensation includes rent and all other charges.

Payment shall be made to the Sub-Contractor on monthly basis by way of e-payment within two weeks from the date of receipt of payment from HINCOL against bills raised by the Sub-Contractor, if found in order and complete in all respect. The mandate format for this purpose is given in the Annexure-IX. The Sub-Contractor shall deposit the GST so charged with the appropriate authority well in time.

**G. Arbitration:**

In the event of any disputes or differences relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the contract, such disputes or differences shall be referred by either party to the Chairman-Cum-Managing Director of NSIC for appointment of a sole arbitrator to adjudicate upon the said dispute or difference and the decision of the arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding on the parties. The Sub-Contractor will not have any objection if the arbitrator so appointed is an employee of NSIC or that such employee, during the course of his regular assignments, has dealt with the subject matter or has expressed his opinion on the subject matter. The provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 shall apply and the venue of the arbitration shall be Jamshedpur.

**H. Qualification of Sub-Contractors :**

- i. The Sub-Contractor should be a reputed person, firm or company in existence for a preferable period of three years and should have the valid authority to submit quotations and enter in to handling agreement with NSIC.
- ii. Sub-Contractor should have a valid GST registration and Permanent Account Number (PAN) from appropriate authorities.
- iii. The Sub-Contractor should preferably have past experience in similar field.
- iv. The Sub-Contractor should have the necessary permission/Authority/Licence from the concerned local or municipal authority to operate the handling of the nature of the product offered.
- v. The Sub-Contractor should own or possess the Godown premises under lease agreement to be valid ideally for a minimum period of 3 years.
- vi. The Sub-Contractor should own or possess handling equipment under hiring arrangement in order to ensure continuous and permanent availability of same at Godown.
- vii. The Sub-Contractor should have the financial capability to handle the godown operations whose evaluation would be done on the basis of assets, financial statements & IT Returns.

**Facilities to be provided by Sub-Contractor at the godown:**

1. Sub-Contractor shall arrange for covered office room of around 150 sq. Ft. for documentation as per HINCOL's procedure within the Depot premises.
2. The Sub-Contractor shall arrange for Electricity connection and payment of charges thereof.
3. The Sub-Contractor shall arrange for one Computer of the latest configuration with laser printer.
4. Internet connectivity is to be provided for which Sub-Contractor will facilitate the installation and the cost will be borne by the Sub-Contractor.
5. At least one computer literate person should be posted at the Godown as he is to make stock receipt entries, generate computerized invoices & other computer related reports.
6. The Sub-Contractor shall install one Telephone and/or arrange Mobile facilities for its staff/officials.
7. A toilet is to be provided adjacent to godown for use by the officials.
8. Adequate security arrangements and cost thereof are to be provided round the clock at the godown.
