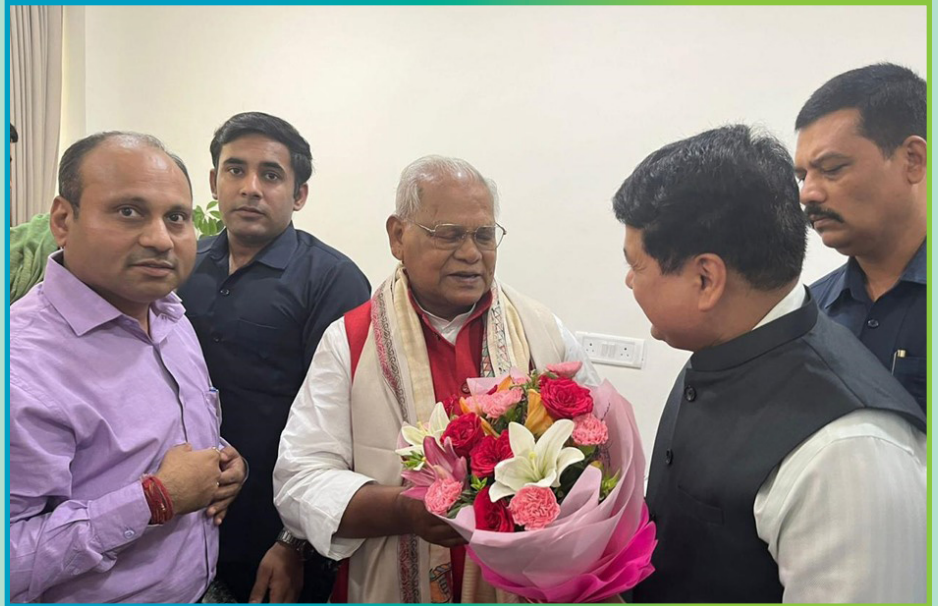

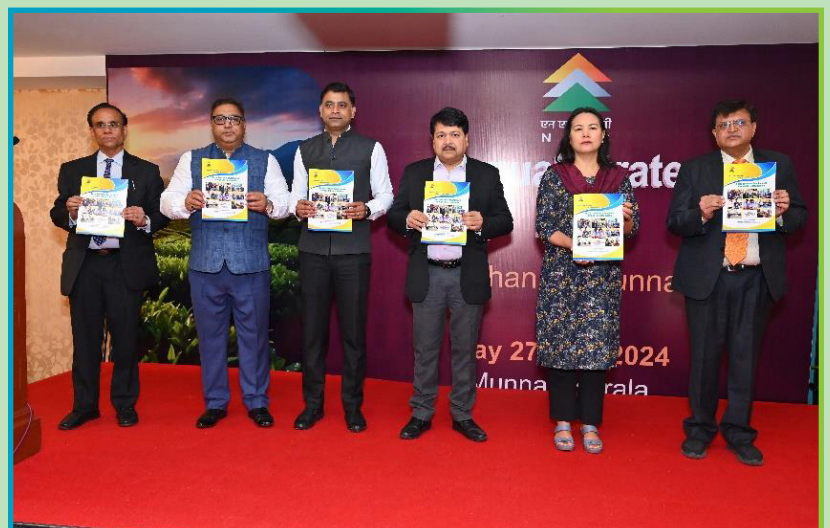
Dr. S S Acharya, CMD, NSIC, delivered the keynote address at "Financial Awareness Conclave"

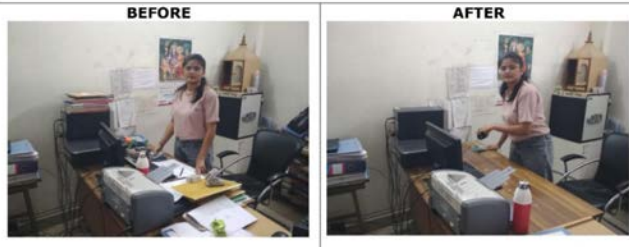

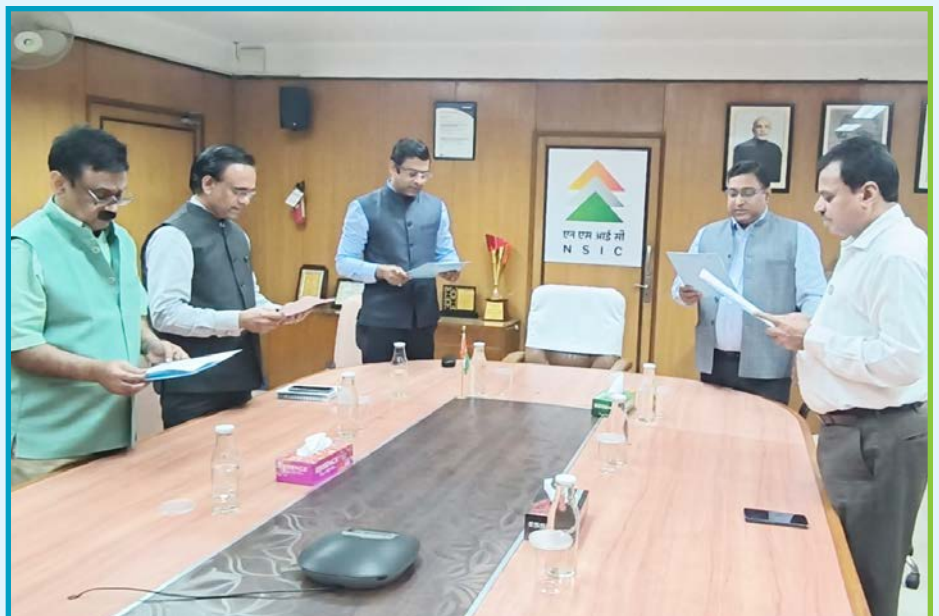
NSIC CELEBRATES INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY
