मैं इस संदेश के पाठकों और राष्ट्रीय लघु उद्योग निगम के सभी कार्मिकों को नववर्ष की शुभकामनाएं देती हूँ और उनकी खुशहाली की कामना करती हूँ।

नववर्ष 2022 के आगमन के अवसर पर आपको यह जानकर प्रसन्नता होगी कि आत्म-निर्भर भारत (एसआरआई) फंड, जो एमएसएमई को विकास पूंजी उपलब्ध करने वाली श्रेणी-11 वैकल्पिक निवेश फंड है, के लिए सूक्ष्म, लघु एवं मध्यम उद्यम मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार, एंकर निवेशक, जो राष्ट्रीय लघु उद्योग निगम लिमिटेड के एनएसआईसी वेंचर कैपिटल फंड लिमिटेड, एआईआर कंपनी की प्रयोजक है और एसवीआई वेंचर लिमिटेड में हाल ही में एक अंशदान करार पर हस्ताक्षर किए हैं। चूंकि सूक्ष्म, लघु एवं मध्यम उद्यम (एमएसएमई) पूरे देश में फैले हुए हैं, इसलिए यह सुनिश्चित करते हुए इस प्रकार इस फंड का संवितरण किया जाएगा कि इसका प्रभाव पूरे देश में सृजित किए जा सके और एनएसआईसी के सहयोग से दूरस्थ क्षेत्रों में स्थित प्रतिष्ठानों तक यह फंड पहुंच सके। इस फंड की शुरुआत एमएसएमई को सहायता पहुंचाने की दृष्टि से की गई है, जो धीरे-धीरे एमएसएमई की सीमाओं से बाहर निकल सके और राष्ट्रीय/अंतरराष्ट्रीय स्तर के प्रतिष्ठान बन सकें।

यह भी बड़े गौरव की बात है कि वर्ष 2020-21 के कारोबार पर कोविड/लॉकडाउन का प्रतिकूल प्रभाव पड़ने के बावजूद इस निगम ने लाभकारिता के संदर्भ में बेहतर परिणाम प्रदर्शित किए हैं। इस वर्ष पीबीटी लाभ 139 करोड़ रुपये है। इस वर्ष में, बीजी प्रोफाइल में सकल परिवर्धन लगभग 600 करोड़ रुपये है। नकारात्मक निवल परिवर्धन के चार वर्ष बाद, वित्त वर्ष 2020-21 में यह देखने की मिला है। एनएसआईसी परिवार के सदस्य के रूप में मुझे आपको यह बताते हुए बहुत ही प्रसन्नता हो रही है कि लहकडाउन के कारण एनएसआईसी के कार्य में कोई कमी नहीं आई है और सूचना प्रौद्योगिक प्रणाली (आईटी सिस्टम) का प्रयोग करते हुए प्रत्येक कार्मिक ने घर से कार्य करके अपना योगदान दिया है। एनएसआईसी के कार्मिकों द्वारा टीम भावना का प्रदर्शन किए बिना यह संभव नहीं हो पाता।

मुझे इस परिवार का सदस्य बनने पर अत्यंत गौरव है, जो समय-समय पर अत्यधिक प्रतिकूल परिस्थितियों और चुनौतियों से उभरा है। मुझे विश्वास है कि एनएसआईसी के कार्मिक वर्ष 2021-22 में भी सतत और सशक्त समर्पण का प्रदर्शन करते रहेंगे।

NSIC (North East) in association with FINER organizes Marketing Campaign

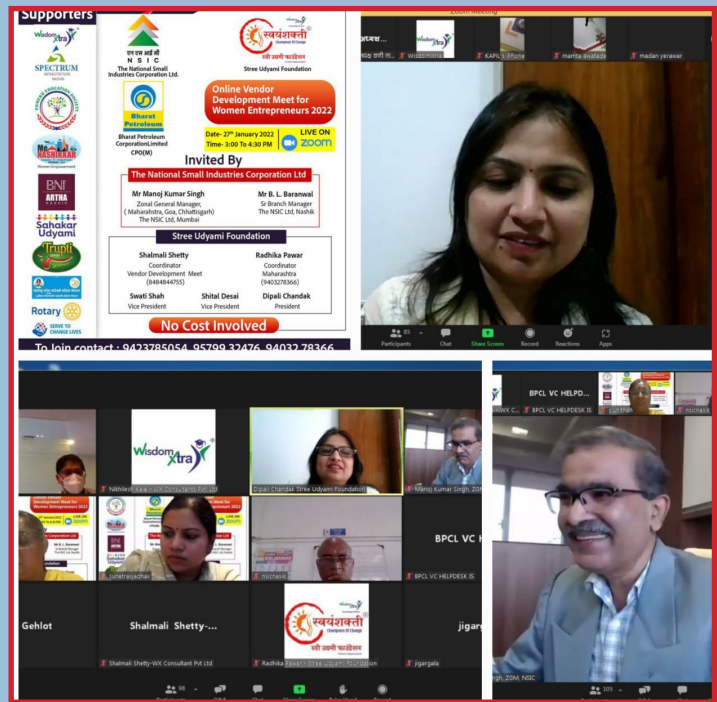

Director (Planning & Marketing) addresses 7th India International MSME EXPO

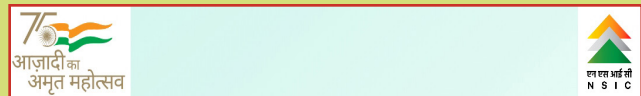

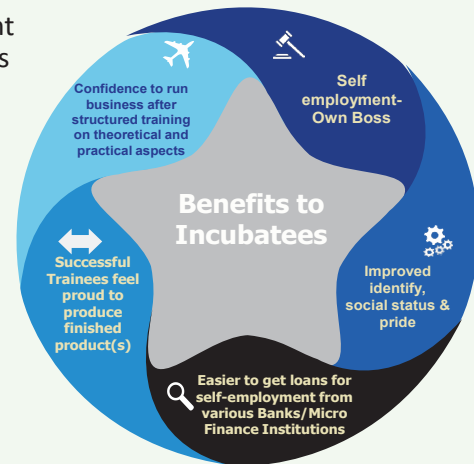

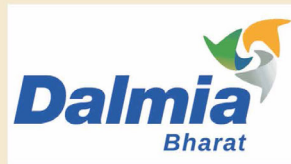
