Raw Material Distribution Scheme

विभोर जैन, आगरा, उत्तर प्रदेश के परिचित उद्यमी हैं। इनकी आयु केवल 36 वर्ष है। इन्होंने पुणे से एम.बी.ए. की शिक्षा प्राप्त की है। इनका संबंध पुरतैनी रूप से व्यापारिक परिवार से है। अपने व्यापार को सही दिशा में आगे बढ़ाने के उद्देश्य से ही उच्च शिक्षा प्राप्त की है।

विभोर जैन की औद्योगिक इकाई का नाम Arya Electrodes Pvt. Ltd. है। यह औद्योगिक इकाई अरतौनी इंडस्ट्रियल एरिया, पनवारी रोड, आगरा में स्थित है। इनका मुख्य व्यापार Manufacturing है। जिसके अंतर्गत Welding Electrodes का निर्माण किया जाता है। इनका संबंध एन.एस.आई.सी. से वर्ष 2011 से है। वो कहते हैं कि एन.एस.आई.सी. से जुड़ने का पूरा श्रेय Steel Authority of India Ltd. (SAIL) को जाता है। इस कारण यह है कि Steel से संबंधित विभिन्न प्रकार की जानकारियों को हासिल करने के लिए वो प्रायः SAIL के दफ्तर में जाते थे क्योंकि उन्हें अपनी औद्योगिक इकाई के उत्पाद के लिए Steel की आवश्यकता होती थी। SAIL के विभाग ने ही विभोर जैन को NSIC से जुड़ने की सलाह दी थी। उन्होंने पहले तो Internet के द्वारा NSIC की Website से NSIC की जानकारी प्राप्त की। जब उन्हें NSIC की Raw Material Distribution योजना का पता चला तो उनकी रुचि बढ़ी। यह योजना विभोर जैन की औद्योगिक इकाई के लिए बेहद कारगर थी। इसलिए उन्होंने NSIC की Agra Branch से सम्पर्क स्थापित किया। वो कहते हैं कि मुझे याद है मैं NSIC की आगरा शाखा के हैड से सीधे जाकर भेंट की थी और लगभग दो घंटों तक जानकारी हासिल करने के साथ अपनी परेशानियां और सवाल जो मन में थे। उनके साथ शेयर किया। मुझे सभी सवालों का बड़ा ही प्रभावी जवाब मिला। इसके बाद मैंने उसी समय Raw Material Distribution की Scheme से जुड़ने का फैसला कर लिया।

विभोर जैन अपनी औद्योगिक इकाई के लिए Raw Material Distribution से जुड़कर योजना का लाभ उठा रहे हैं। उन्हें कच्चा माल प्राप्त करने में किसी भी तरह की परेशानी नहीं होती है। वो कहते हैं कि इस योजना के कारण 275/- रुपये Per Metric Ton का सीधा लाभ मिलता है। यह बहुत बड़ी सहायता है। इससे लघु औद्योगिक इकाई को विकसित होने का अवसर अवश्य मिलेगा।

इसमें कोई संदेह नहीं कि NSIC की योजना Raw Material Distribution के द्वारा विभोर जैन की कम्पनी Arya Electrodes Pvt. Ltd. ने व्यापार की क्षमता को बढ़ाने में सफलता प्राप्त की है। इसका सबूत है प्रत्येक वर्ष कम्पनी का बढ़ता हुआ टर्न ओवर।
