Certificate in lieu of Para 26(6) of the EPF Scheme

This certificate is being issued to the employees who are EPS-95 members of The National Small Industries Corporation Ltd. (Establishment Code No. DSNHP0000932 & DSNHP0000904) as per the requirement mandated by EPFO Circular No. Pension / 2022 / 56529 / 654 dated 20th February, 2023. As per clause 6 (vii) of this circular, employees have been advised to submit proof of remittance of employer's share in Provident Fund on higher wages exceeding the corresponding prevalent wage ceiling specified by EPFO and proof of joint option under Para 26(6) of EPF scheme.

We hereby confirm that this certificate is being issued to the eligible EPS-95 members of The National Small Industries Corporation Ltd., an exempted Provident Fund Trust which has been granted exemption under para 17(1)(a) of the Employees' Provident Fund Scheme, 1952, vide order dated 25th July, 1979, so that the holder can use this certificate in lieu of proof of Joint Option under Para 26(6) of the Scheme.

As per the approved trust rules which have been duly approved by EPFO, Employer and Employees have been contributing to PF on actual wages. The relevant extract of trust rules are given below.

Rule 10. Contribution by Members

(a) Every member shall subscribe to the Fund every month a sum equal to 12% of the total of his monthly basic pay, dearness allowance and retaining allowance, if any.

Rule 11. Employer's Contribution to the Fund

(a) The Employer shall not later than 15th day of the succeeding month, in respect of each of the members of the fund, pay to the Trust as Employer's contribution to the Fund a sum equal to the total of the Members's compulsory contribution under rule 10(a) hereinbefore.

In line with above rules of the Provident Fund of The National Small Industries Corporation Ltd., the Employer and Employees have been contributing to Provident Fund on higher actual wages exceeding the prevalent wage ceilings of Rs.5,000 / Rs.6,500 / Rs.15,000, as the case may be, alongwith the inspection charges which are also remitted on actual wages. Monthly returns have been regularly filed with the EPFO.

In view of the above, this certificate may be accepted in lieu of proof of joint option under Para 26 (6) of EPF Scheme by eligible EPS-95 members of The National Small Industries Corporation Ltd.
